

Session Information Descriptions

Research Session (25 or 50 minutes)

This session is designed for the presentation of a research project or study. Audience members will have time at the end of a presentation to ask questions of the presenter.

Regular Session (25 or 50 minutes or 75 min workshop format)

This session is designed to present information on projects, course innovations, program innovations or other science and mathematics initiatives. Audience members will have time at the end of a presentation to ask questions of the presenter. The workshops are expected to be interactive and engaging throughout.

Symposium/Panel Session (50 minutes)

This session is designed for differing presenters to provide insight into a topic of interest. Each presenter will speak for an allotted amount of time. Audience members will have time at the end of the symposium/panel discussion to ask questions of the presenters.

Innovations Showcase (50 minutes)

This session is designed for teachers and/or educators to propose ideas to "showcase" hands-on, technology-related, open-ended problem solving, mathematics and science integration activities that can be shared in an open-forum format. (This session will be on Saturday only.)

Quick Fire (15 minutes)

This session is designed to provide participants an opportunity to share ideas on an emerging trend, "hot topic" of interest, form collaborations, or gain feedback on a new idea. Session organizers are asked to facilitate a sharing of ideas.

Syllabus Share (50 minutes)

This session is designed for participants to bring syllabi and course activities to share for a specific course (e.g. methods courses, content seminar courses, etc.).
