

CONNECTIONS AWARD

Description: The SSMA recognizes exemplary K-12 teaching and learning projects that focus on connections between science and mathematics with the SSMA Connections Award. The nominee should be a person working in K-12 who has been a leader of an exemplary teaching and learning project that is school-based and focused on connections between science and mathematics.

What is required: To nominate a person for this reward, send:

1. A letter of nomination describing the nominee's contribution to K-12 science and mathematics teaching and learning.
2. A description of the project.

Awardee: The awardee will receive a \$500 award, a conference fee waiver to the annual SSMA Convention where the award will be presented, and an invitation to present a session at the Annual Convention about their work. Additional funds may be available to support awardee(s) travel to the annual convention. This award may be given annually.
